Program Scope

All gas and oil direct heating equipment whose energy input ratings are within the parameters outlined below are included in the program: "Vented home heating equipment" or "vented heater" means a class of home heating equipment, not including furnaces, designed to furnish warm air to the living space of a residence, directly from the device, without duct connections (except that booths not to exceed 10 inches beyond the casing may be permitted) and includes: vented wall furnaces, vented floor furnace, and vented room heater.
